Brandon Rosser, 6'5, Temecula Valley, 2013. Has spurts of great play. Gravitates to three line to much, but can stroke it. Needs drive game better. Good rebounder with soft touch on put backs. Needs to def board better. Soft hands and good passer. HUGE UPSIDE!

John Payne, 6'2, Temecula Valley, 2011. Monster athlete. Goes right a lot and needs to develop left. Big rebounder that can guard multiple positions. OK shot to 17 feet. Must improve handles to be serious college recruite.

Tonye Akaomande, 6'0, Citrus Hill, 2012 Freaky athlete. Cat quick and explosive. Needs to develop better outside shot. Can finish at the rim hard. Takes some possessions off, and when focused is “un guardable”. Can be a major impact player at the college level if his skill level reaches his athletic level. Great kid too!

Henry Vinson, 6'3, Eisenhower, 2011, Nice two guard with above average skill sets. Plays hard and understands game very well. Needs to rebound better on both sides. Good shooter with a nice drive game. Makes players around him better.

Roderick Evan Taylor, Upland, 6'4, 2011 Very cagey long athlete. Looked for shot to much and needs to get other players involved. Nice upside if he gets stronger. Can make plays! Has to rebound better too. Defensively is capable of guarding multiple positions. Big upside.

Jeremy Bass, Dana Hills, 6'3, 2011 Deceiving player that knows how to play and will play to a role. Not a number, but a basketball player. Nice understanding of game and did multiple things well. Very strong and can guard the ball. Needs to get a little quicker. Tough kid.

Heath Hairston, Lakeside, 5'9, 2011 Very quick kid with nice skill set. Makes good decisions and reminds me of a football corner back. Things he is a pit bull! Nice athleticism and makes good decisions. Plays to level of comp sometimes. Nice upside.

Anthony Fitzpatrick, Upland, 6'3 2011 A player with a nice motor. Can guard multiple positions. Good rebounder. Needs to play better defense. Makes good decisions. Has to play hard all the time. Nice upside if he develops his handles. Above average athlete.

DJ Green, Lakeside, 5'8, 2011 Nice PG with a nice motor. Makes great decisions and looks like a million bucks and than burps up something. Can guard a jet quick pg. Shot needs to get better. Nice in transition. Tough kid that will only get better. Nice game will only get better.

Kevin Johnson, Temecula Valley, 6'1, 2011 Explosive rebounder that can get a lot of put back dunks in a game. Has to get better handles and understanding of game in order to be good college prospect. Needs to rebound better def as well. Coachable kid with decent concept of game. Can guard multiple positons.
